## Town of Luther Ordinance 2017-06-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-303 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, MODIFYING LIMITING AND RESTORING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH FIREWORKS MAY BE USED, FIRED, AND/OR DISCHARGED WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA THAT:

## Section No. 1: Part 10-303.D is amended to read as follows:

- D. Each fireworks stand shall post notice, in a conspicuous place, that it is a violation of the ordinances of the town to discharge any fireworks within the town limits at any time, except for June 30 July 4 of each calendar year at the following times:
  - a. Sunday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
  - b. Friday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. If times and dates need to be extended by one day, approval may be granted by a written document approved by the Mayor, Fire Chief, and Police Chief.

## Section No. 2: Part 10-303.E is amended to read as follows:

- E. The use of fireworks within the corporate limits of the town is prohibited, except for June 30 July 4 of each calendar year at the following times:
  - a. Sunday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
  - b. Friday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. If times and dates need to be extended by one day, approval may be granted by a written document approved by the Mayor, Fire Chief, and Police Chief.

Section No. 3: That the Town Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published as required by law.

Section No. 4:

Emergency Claus. An emergency is hereby deemed and declared to exist whereby it is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Luther, Oklahoma, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval, and adoption.

**Passed and Approved** by the Mayor and Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Luther, Oklahoma this **13th day of June**, **2017**, by vote on Sections No's 1, 2, and 3, then be separate vote on Section No. 4 (the emergency clause).
