

ORDINANCE 2018-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA AMENDING SECTION 13-305 OF THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA AMENDING THE SECTION NAME AND TEXT BODY TO INCLUDE THE TERM "EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CHANGE TERMINOLOGY; DECLARING REPEALER; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That Section 13-305 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Luther Oklahoma shall be amended as follows:

13-305: EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE; EMERGENCY POWERS.

In the event of a national emergency or emergency resulting from natural causes, the director of emergency management and civil defense, after due authorization from the town board of trustees of the town, shall have the power and authority to enforce all rules and regulation relating to emergency management and civil defense and, if necessary take control of transportation, communications, stocks of fuel, food, clothing, medicine and public utilities for the purpose of protecting the civilian population. He shall cooperate in every way with the activities of other governmental agencies or emergency management and civil defense organizations. IF required by the mayor, he shall have control over any and all funds allocated from any source for the purpose of alleviating distress conditions in the town.

Section 2. **REPEALER.**


All former ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. **SEVERABILITY.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the Town of Luther and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, as provided by law.
