

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 7-105, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, LUTHER, OKLAHOMA, PROVIDING FOR WHEN PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES IS REQUIRED, TO ALLOW THE GENERAL BUSINESS OFFICE MANAGER TO MAKE PURCHASES OR ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR EMERGENCY SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT, REPAIRS, OR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES WHICH ARE NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN OPERATIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000, AND REQUIRING RATIFICATION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES TO THE CONTRARY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA THAT:

SECTION I. Section 7-105 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Luther, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 7-105 **WHEN PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES IS REQUIRED**

- A. Every contract for, or purchase of, supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services for more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) shall require the prior approval of the Town Board of Trustees. Under no circumstances, except as provided in Subsection B, may such contract or purchase be made without first obtaining the approval of the Board of Trustees.
- B. The general business office manager shall be authorized to purchase or contract for emergency supplies, materials, equipment, repairs, or contractual services which are necessary to maintain operations. This authorization shall not exceed the sum of ~~\$5,000.00~~ and any purchase or contract shall be ratified at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION II. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION III. If any part, article, section, or subsection of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, notwithstanding such holding.

SECTION IV. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Town of Luther and the inhabitants thereof that this ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
