RESOLUTION NO. 2019-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA, ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMITS ON LUTHER ROAD AND HOGBACK ROAD, BETWEEN NE 178TH STREET AND HIGHWAY 66, AT 35 MILES PER HOUR, EXCEPT FOR SCHOOL ZONES PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED, AND DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF SPEED LIMIT SIGNS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

WHEREAS, Section 15-601 of the Luther Code of Ordinances provides for the installation of traffic-control devices; and

WHEREAS, this Section specifically provides in pertinent part that "the town board of trustees, by motion or resolution, shall have placed and maintained traffic-control signs, signals, and devices...as they may deem necessary to regulate traffic under the traffic ordinances of this town or under state law or to guide or warn traffic;"

WHEREAS, the Board desires to establish the speed limits on Luther Road and Hogback Road, between NE 178th Street and Highway 66, at 35 miles per hour, except for school zones previously established; and

WHEREAS, the Board further desires to direct the placement of speed limit signs in compliance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA, THAT the speed limits on Luther Road and Hogback Road, between NE 178th Street and Highway 66, are set at 35 miles per hour, except for school zones previously established; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT speed limit signs are hereby directed to be placed on Luther Road and Hogback Road between NE 178th Street and Highway 66, in compliance with the terms of this Resolution and in compliance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
