

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE OKLAHOMA SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE 9-1-1 DISPATCH SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, 74 O.S. 1981, Section 1001, *et seq.*, authorizes public agencies to enter into agreements to jointly act to exercise any powers and authority conferred upon them; and

WHEREAS, the Nine-One-One Emergency Number Act, 63 O.S. Supp. 1986, Section 2811, *et seq.*, authorizes establishment of the 911 primary emergency telephone number, and encourages units of local government and combinations or associations of such units to develop and improve emergency communication procedures and facilities utilizing the 911 emergency telephone number; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Luther, Oklahoma has entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the 9-1-1 Association of Central Oklahoma Governments regarding funding for 9-1-1 services for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Luther, Oklahoma received a letter dated December 2019, from the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office reporting that 9-1-1 dispatch services would cease for Luther, Oklahoma, as of November 6, 2019, changing 9-1-1 dispatch services to the Oklahoma City Police Department resulting in considerable additional charges over those agreed upon between the Town of Luther and ACOG 9-1-1; and

WHEREAS, despite this correspondence, Oklahoma County Sheriff, P.D. Taylor offered to continue UHF 9-1-1 dispatch for the Town of Luther through June 2021, at the current rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER THAT the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Department is authorized to continue the provision of 9-1-1 dispatch services for the Town of Luther at current rates until at least June 2021.

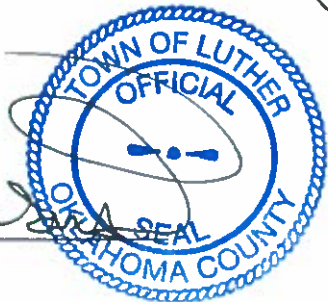
