

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-09**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 2-102 OF THE LUTHER CODE OF ORDINANCES, "ELECTIVE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN," AND SPECIFICALLY REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE CLERK-TREASURER BE ELECTED; ADDING SECTION 2-300, "CLERK-TREASURER," AND SPECIFICALLY REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE CLERK-TREASURER BE ELECTED; REPEALING SECTION 2-302.1, "TOWN CLERK-TREASURER;" REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2021-02; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LUTHER, OKLAHOMA:**

**SECTION I.** Section 2-102 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Luther, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 2-102 ELECTIVE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN:**

The following officers of the Town are elected by the registered voters of the Town: one Trustee from each ward of the Town, but all Trustees are elected at large.

**SECTION II.** Section 2-300 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Luther, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 2-300 TOWN CLERK-TREASURER**

A. There is hereby created the office of Town Clerk-Treasurer, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Board of Trustees. The Clerk-Treasurer shall serve at the will of the Board of Trustees.

B. The Clerk-Treasurer shall have and exercise all powers and duties assigned by statute and ordinance and such other authority as may be granted by the Board of Trustees.

**SECTION III.** Section 2-302.1 shall be repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION IV.** Ordinance Number 2021-02 shall be repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION V.** This Ordinance shall become and be effective on and after July 13, 2021, subject to approval by a majority of the registered voters of the Town of Luther, Oklahoma, voting on same in the manner prescribed by Oklahoma State Statute.

**SECTION VI.** All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION VII.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part

thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.
